

Fujitsu General's VRFs Win First Big Order in Chile

Fujitsu General's variable refrigerant flow (VRF) systems won their first large-scale order in Chile through the sales and service company Eurofred Chile. Fujitsu General was selected amid fierce competition owing to a combination of factors including high product quality and after-sales service.

Provida, a health insurance company in Chile, decided to refurbish the air conditioning systems in its building with 18 floors and a total area of 12,000 m², located in the Sanhattan area of Santiago. The existing chillers and fan coil units will be replaced with Fujitsu General's heat-recovery VRF systems, consisting of 402 indoor and 58 outdoor units with a total capacity of 2,020 kW (792 hp).
